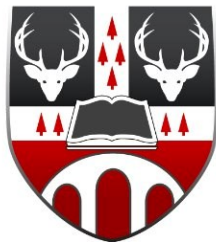

Nothing stops Bridgtown pupils!



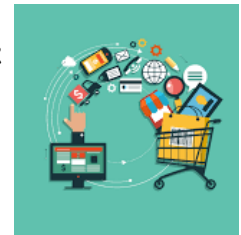
Year 5/6 are taking part in the daily mile where they run, jog, walk for 15 minutes.
