Nursery

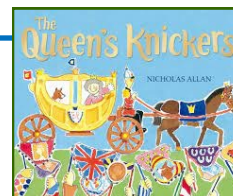
Nursery children will read the Queen's Handbag.

They also have a 'tea and scones' activity planned.

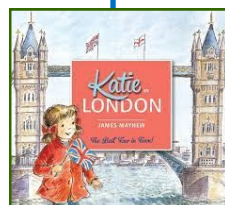


Reception

Year 1 will be reading The Queen's Hat.

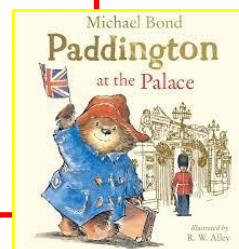


They will then design and make their own style of crown.

Red, White, Blue Day

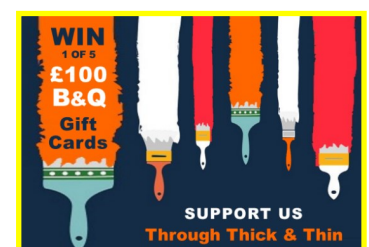
The last day of term, Friday 27th May, will be a non-uniform day. The theme will be 'Red, White, Blue'. We are asking that children come to school dressed in these colours.
